A graduate in Arabic literature, Majida El Roumi saw her artistic career take off thanks to the acclaimed "Kalimat", by the great poet Nizar Qabbani, which is to this day an anthem in the Arab world. She offered a multitude of beautiful melodies and exquisite poems magnified by her unique voice. Songs such as «Ib7at 3anni», «Maa Al Jarida», «Koun Sadi9i», «O7ebbok wa ba3d», «E3tazalt El Gharam» and «Saqata Al Qina» are today considered classics.
